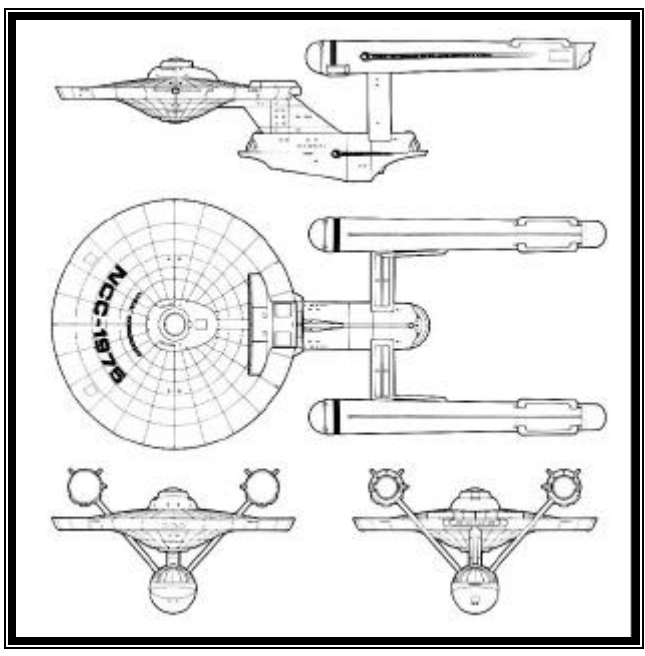

Notes:
The Coronado class ships were designed specifically to operate large numbers of small to medium-size craft from a typical cruiser-size hull. They are extremely effective in tactical situations and can act as a command ship for their own embarked craft or those of an entire task force. Coronado class ships are useful in "showing the flag" because of the variety of craft they can embark. They have increasingly been used in situations where a capable presence or show of force is desired, but where the use of other ships, such as a carrier, would be to provoking.
