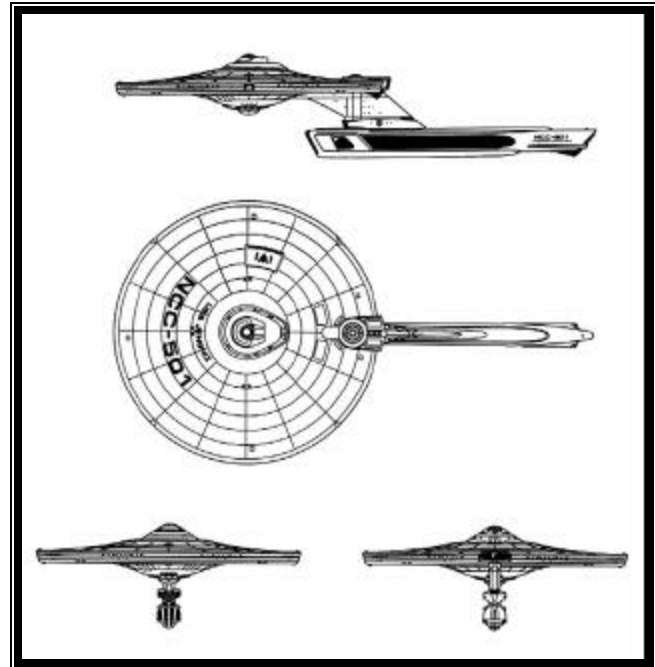
The Jenghiz class, launched in early 2269, was created from upgrades to the old and outdated Saladin class of Destroyer. Built to incorporate improvements in warp technology, the Jenghiz, like the Enterprise, looked radically different enough to become a new class of vessel. Powerful and maneuverable, the Jenghiz has proved a valuable patrol and support vessel, and is still on patrol along the Cardassian/Dominion, and Romulan borders.

The Mk I was the first destroyer which incorporated the separate torpedo launch system that soon became standard on most Federation designs. This unique placement of the torpedo tracks and exhaust system allowed for more powerful torpedoes to be used, with the added bonus of providing significantly more internal space for research and crew compartments. The Mk I also increased the main power by installing the FWC-2, which was installed successfully on the Saladin Mk III. With the movement of the torpedo system, the larger FIF-1 impulse drive could also be installed. The Mk I soon was on patrol along every major border, and was one of the most powerful single engine combat vessels of it's day.

None the less, in 2276, Star Fleet review boards had found that the Jenghiz's lack of long range phasers had caused serious danger to the crew and Federation interests. In 2277, the Mk II was launched, which increased the range of the phasers and the power of the shield system. The Mk II remained in production until 2301, when the improved M-3b was installed. The M-3b allowed the Jenghiz, which had been moved from front line duty to be reclassified as a forward combat vessel and breathed new life into the design. With nearly a 50% power increase, the Mk III went on to be the support vessel in over 40 various fleets, and became the primary exploration escort vessel, with no less than 30 being assigned to Galaxy Exploration Command as escorts.

The Mk IV, still in production, introduced new technologies and increased the power of both the Warp and Impulse drive, as well as weapons and defenses. The Mk IV is also used by Star Fleet Intelligence for team retrieval and to collect observation equipment along hostile borders. Then Mk IV, which has nearly the power of older cruisers, is considered the most successful single engine design in the Federation inventory.

The Jenghiz is currently produced at the Sol III San Francisco Shipyards and Kiev Orbital Station, as well as the Andorian Chokis shipyards at a rate of 6 per year. Although more modern designs are phasing out the Jenghiz, the power and adaptability of the small destroyer insure that production will continue for years to come. Of the 232 built to date, 2 are reported as missing, 11 have been destroyed, including 3 Mk IV in recent successful fleet actions against the Cardassian/Dominion fleet. 5 have been scrapped, one after a collision with a Packlid vessel, and 6 are used as training vessels. One was captured by Orion forces, and six have been disarmed and sold to civilian concerns. One of these is feared re-armed and in use in the Triangle.
